Background

Green roofs (and walls) can contribute to sustainable development by providing solutions to stormwater management, climate change mitigation and adaptation, and providing a landscape that reflects local biodiversity and character. Alongside this they can add wider benefits including amenity, quality of life and protection of the building fabric.

Although green roof technology is mainstream in most of Europe, in the UK there is a need to develop further understanding and expertise to make sure that their increasing popularity delivers long term sustainable solutions.

CIRIA's new guidance Building Greener (publication C644) covers the design, construction and maintenance of green roofs, green walls and complementary methods of enhancing biodiversity.

The presentations from guidance authors, steering group members and other key experts will cover biodiversity, stormwater management and thermal performance, looking at case studies to demonstrate practical implementation and dispel myths.

This event will be of interest to clients, planners, contractors and consultants interested in incorporating green roofs on their projects. Delegates will gain:

- An understanding of the environmental, ecological, social and economic benefits of green roofs and associated features
- An appreciation of the appropriate technologies and their management to meet varying objectives
