  - What new partnerships should achieve?

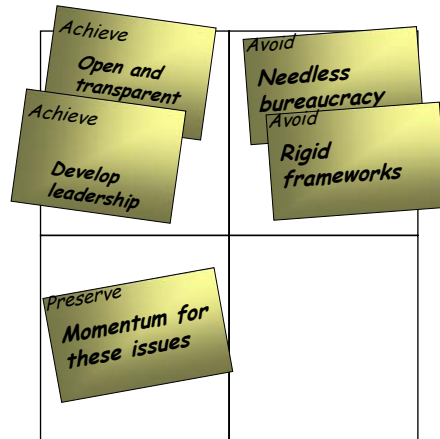
