## Protection and Resilience Consultation – Consultation process

- Role of the Consultation – to collect stakeholder views on shortlisted options
- Timescale – 3 months to end October 2008
- 4 Resilience Consultation events planned – to focus thinking prior to submission of consultation responses
- Consultation responses will be collated and a report produced of the key findings

- **Consultation responses will be analysed to:**
  - Identify preferred option(s)
  - Identify improvements and practical approaches
  - Clarify the rationale for the selection(s)
  - Develop a submission for presentation to Ministers on the preferred option(s)

## Protection and Resilience Consultation – Taking the result forward

- Submit proposals to Ministers – Spring 2009
- Develop Industry capacity – ongoing
  - Surveys; Quality standards (e.g. Kitemark); construction expertise
- Develop funding procedures
  - Forward planning; Selection of properties – EA, LAs, local community consultation; Grant approval process
